National Tea Day


We celebrated National Tea Day by playing ping pong teacups. Not as easy as it looked for residents and staff alike, however, it provided plenty of giggles throughout the day.

After settling the Miffy vs Tiffy debate we sat and enjoyed tea in china cups and some rather yummy cake.

























OUTDOORS

ACTIVITIES


