

Poem to Share


Song of Hope

We are happy to receive feedback at any time and strongly encourage everyone to contribute so that we can ensure that we continue to do the BEST we can.



Lauren is 19 years old and the youngest member of our Wellbeing Team.


She has two cats, who are also her fur-babies, called Tommy and Polly (after Peaky Blinders characters). and a horse named Daisy-Doo.
